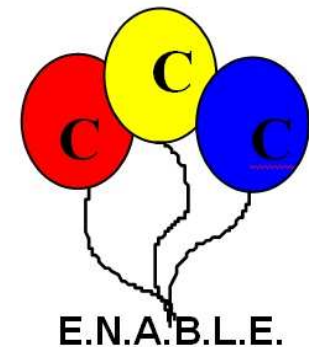

Who?

ENABLE is a registered charity supporting Caerphilly Children's Centre.

Members include parents, staff, and friends from all sections of the community.

Caerphilly Children's Centre opened in 1990 and provides high quality medical, therapy, play, support and respite services to families in the Caerphilly County Borough area, who have a child or young person, aged 0-18 years, with a disability.



What?

Since 1990 Caerphilly Children's Centre has continued to expand and is now in contact with over 800 families.

Many of the improvements would not have been possible without the support of ENABLE. These include a new therapy extension incorporating a hydrotherapy pool, an audio visual room, additional staff accommodation, a new reception and waiting area with a weighing and measuring room. An Information and Advice Centre was completed in 2004 following a successful bid to the Community Fund. We have currently completed the building of an additional Therapy Room.
